10 Ways Of Practicing Righteousness

1 Jn 3:7 (NKJV) — 7 Little children, let no one deceive you. He who practices righteousness is righteous, just as He is righteous.

- 1. **Obey God's Commandments:** This is foundational to biblical righteousness. Deuteronomy 6:25, obedience to God's commandments is considered righteousness.
- 2. **Have Faith in Jesus Christ:** Righteousness is linked to faith in Jesus. Romans 3:22 states that righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe.
- 3. **Love God and Your Neighbor:** Jesus summarizes the Law as loving God with all your heart, soul, and mind and loving your neighbor as yourself (Matthew 22:37-40). Acting in love fulfills the law and is a practical expression of righteousness.
- 4. **Pursue Justice and Mercy:** Micah 6:8 directs us to act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with God. Righteousness involves advocating for justice and showing mercy to others.
- 5. **Practice Humility:** Biblical righteousness is not self-righteous or prideful but is marked by humility. Philippians 2:3-4 encourages us to consider others better than ourselves and look out for the interests of others.
- 6. **Engage in Spiritual Disciplines:** Practices such as prayer, fasting, attending church, and studying Scripture are ways to cultivate a righteous life, as they help us align with God's will and character (2 Timothy 3:16-17).
- 7. **Integrity and Honesty:** Living righteously includes being honest and having moral integrity in one's dealings. Proverbs 11:3 emphasizes that the integrity of the upright guides them.
- 8. **Generosity and Giving:** Generous acts of giving reflect God's character and are considered righteous (2 Corinthians 9:9).
- 9. **Forgiveness:** Extending forgiveness to others as God has forgiven us is a key aspect of practicing righteousness (Ephesians 4:32).
- 10. **Moral Purity:** Righteous living includes personal holiness and purity in conduct. 1 Peter 1:15-16 calls us to be holy in all our behavior.

Remember: these are not just to be outside actions. You must do them with a sincere heart, for God looks at the heart. Je 17:10 (NKJV) — 10 I, the Lord, search the heart, I test the mind, Even to give every man according to his ways, According to the fruit of his doings.

 children of the devil: <u>whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God,</u> nor is the one
 who does not love his brother.

 - The practice of righteousness reveals our faith in Christ to impute righteousness apart from works.
- Jas 2:18 (ESV) 18 But someone will say, "You have faith and I have works." Show me your faith apart from your works, and I will show you my faith by my works.
- 2 Co 5:21 (ESV) 21 For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that *in him* we might become the righteousness of God.
- Pr 21:21 (ESV) 21 Whoever pursues righteousness and kindness will find life, righteousness, and honor.
- Ps 34:15 (NKJV) 15 The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, And His ears are open to their cry.
- Is 3:10 (NKJV) 10 "Say to the righteous that it shall be well with them, For they shall eat the fruit of their doings.
- Mt 6:33 (NKJV) 33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.
