

***The Son of Man Is Glorified - Summary and Questions for Study***

**Judas and Darkness**

- Judas leaves after receiving bread; “and it was night” (John 13:30).
- Symbolism: leaving the light of Christ and entering spiritual darkness.
- Jesus = the Light of the World (John 1, 3, 8, 12).
- Judas aligns with Satan; Jesus accepts this as “the hour of darkness” (Luke 22:53).

**Light vs. Darkness**

- Darkness = sin, blindness, last days’ moral decay (2 Tim. 3).
- Disciples remain in the light with Jesus.
- God calls His people to live as “sons of light.”

**Jesus Glorified in Death**

- Jesus’ death is His glorification (John 13:31-32).
- Though cursed on the tree (Deut. 21, Gal. 3), His death brings life and redemption.
- His obedience reverses Adam’s disobedience.
- Man’s chief end: glorify God and enjoy Him forever (Westminster Shorter Catechism).

**Victory Through the Cross**

- By His death, He destroys the power of death and the devil (Heb. 2).
- He lays down His life willingly (John 10).
- He sits at God’s right hand (Luke 22, Acts 7).
- All creation will bow to Him (Phil. 2).

**God’s Justice and Holiness**

- Sin must be punished (Ex. 34, Zech. 13).
- Jesus bore the curse and God’s wrath on the cross (Gal. 3, Matt. 27, Ps. 22).
- God’s holiness is revealed in forsaking His Son.

**God’s Love**

- Through the cross, God demonstrates His love (John 3:16).
- Jesus redeems, reconciles, and gives believers the right to be God’s children.
